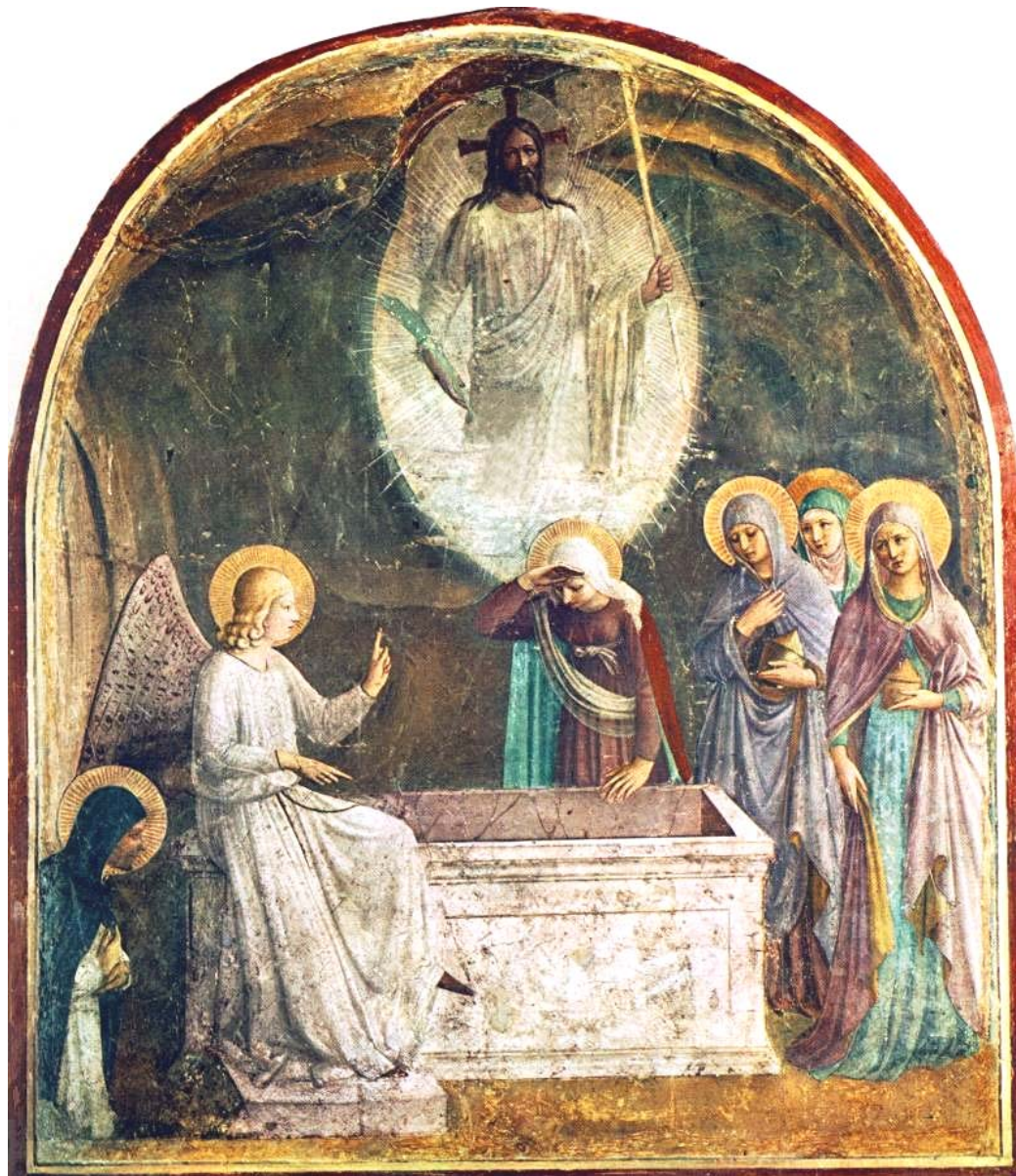

Gospel

Luke 19:1-10

Some Sadducees, those who deny that there is a resurrection, came forward and put this question to him, saying, "Teacher, Moses wrote for us, 'If someone's brother dies leaving a wife but no child, his brother must take the wife and raise up descendants for his brother.'

Now there were seven brothers; the first married a woman but died childless.

Then the second and the third married her, and likewise all the seven died childless.

Finally the woman also died.

Now at the resurrection whose wife will that woman be? For all seven had been married to her."

Jesus said to them, "The children of this age marry and remarry; but those who are deemed worthy to attain to the coming age and to the resurrection of the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage.

They can no longer die, for they are like angels; and they are the children of God because they are the ones who will rise.

That the dead will rise even Moses made known in the passage about the bush, when he called 'Lord' the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob; and he is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive."

Please arrive by 7:45 am if you plan to hear confessions and no later than 9 am if you are concelebrating the Mass.

- You can register for as many tickets as you need as long as they are still available. However, you can only reserve a maximum of 100 tickets at a time.
- Ticket holders must enter your location by 8:00 am after which we will open the doors to those who have waiting list tickets. We can not guarantee entrance to anyone after 8:00 am, even if part of your group is already inside. Please secure your seats upon entering.
- Once you have entered the Verizon Center or DC Armory, do not leave the building. *You will not be allowed back in even with a ticket.*
- We will be issuing a limited number of waiting list tickets. Those with waiting list tickets will be given specific instructions, upon receiving their tickets. These ticket holders will be given access to open seating should any become available on the day of the event.
