Gospel

John 10:1-10

Jesus said: "Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever does not enter a sheepfold through the gate but climbs over elsewhere is a thief and a robber. But whoever enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens it for him, and the sheep hear his voice, as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has driven out all his own, he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice. But they will not follow a stranger; they will run away from him, because they do not recognize the voice of strangers."

Although Jesus used this figure of speech, the Pharisees did not realize what he was trying to tell them. So Jesus said again, "Amen, amen, I say to you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. A thief comes only to steal and slaughter and destroy; I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly."

Today we celebrate the First Communion of over 120 children of our Parish!

St. John Bosco tells us that on the day of his First Communion, St. Dominic made four promises to God, and was faithful to them until the day of his death, when he was 15 years of age. It reads: "Promises that I, Dominic Savio, made to God in the year of 1849, at seven years of age, on the day of my first communion:

First, I will go often to confession, and will receive holy communion as often as possible.

Second, I will sanctify the feast days of the Church.

Third, my best friend will be Jesus and Mary.

Fourth, I would rather die, than commit a sin.

It is possible for us to be saints, because we have Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who will never abandon us. We have the Eucharist! St. Jerome says that, "If Christ did not want to dismiss the Jews without food in the desert for fear that they would collapse on the way, it was to teach us that it is dangerous to try to get to heaven without the Bread of Heaven." Let us pray for all these children from our parish who this weekend will receive Jesus for the first time.
