Pastor's Corner

Jesus tells the apostles not to be afraid, and that He will pray to the Father so that the Father will send them another Counselor, the Holy Spirit, to be with us forever. What for? To love Jesus, for as He says: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." Now, as we saw last week, genuine love must express itself in deeds. "This indeed is love: obeying and believing in the loved one" (St John Chrysostom). Therefore, Jesus wants us to understand that love of God, if it is to be authentic, must be reflected in a life of generous and faithful self-giving, obedient to the will of God: he who accepts God's commandments and obeys them, he it is who loves him. This divine love, according to St Thomas, operates four things in our souls, which we must desire with our whole heart:

- 1) The love of God produces in us **our spiritual life**. "God is love, and those who abide in love abide in God, and God abides in them" (1 John 4:16).
- 2) Love of God also produces the **observance of the divine commandments**. "Those who love me will keep my word" (John 14:23).
- 3) The third effect is that the love of God is a **great help against any adversity**. As St. Paul says: "all things work together for good for those who love God" (Rom. 8, 28).
- 4) The fourth effect of charity is that it **brings joy to the soul**, because it leads us to everlasting life.

World Youth Day Madrid 2011



For WYD 2011 in Madrid, we are organizing a 30-day trip to some of the most important Catholic shrines (especially Marian shrines) in the entire world, and will also include many important cultural sites. We are going to visit Fatima, Lourdes, Santiago de Compostela, and Barcelona, in addition to Madrid and many other incredible places! It will be an incredible time. Its true that travel isn't cheap, but we're used to working on a shoestring budget (of course, this means not sleeping in hotels or eating in restaurants, etc), and so we can pretty much guarantee that our trip will be less expensive than just about anything comparable that you'd be able to find anywhere else--the total cost for the 29 days is \$2,500 including international airfare, food and accommodations (compare that with anything else out there!). Please note that in order to accompany us on this pilgrimage, you must confirm your participation ASAP!
