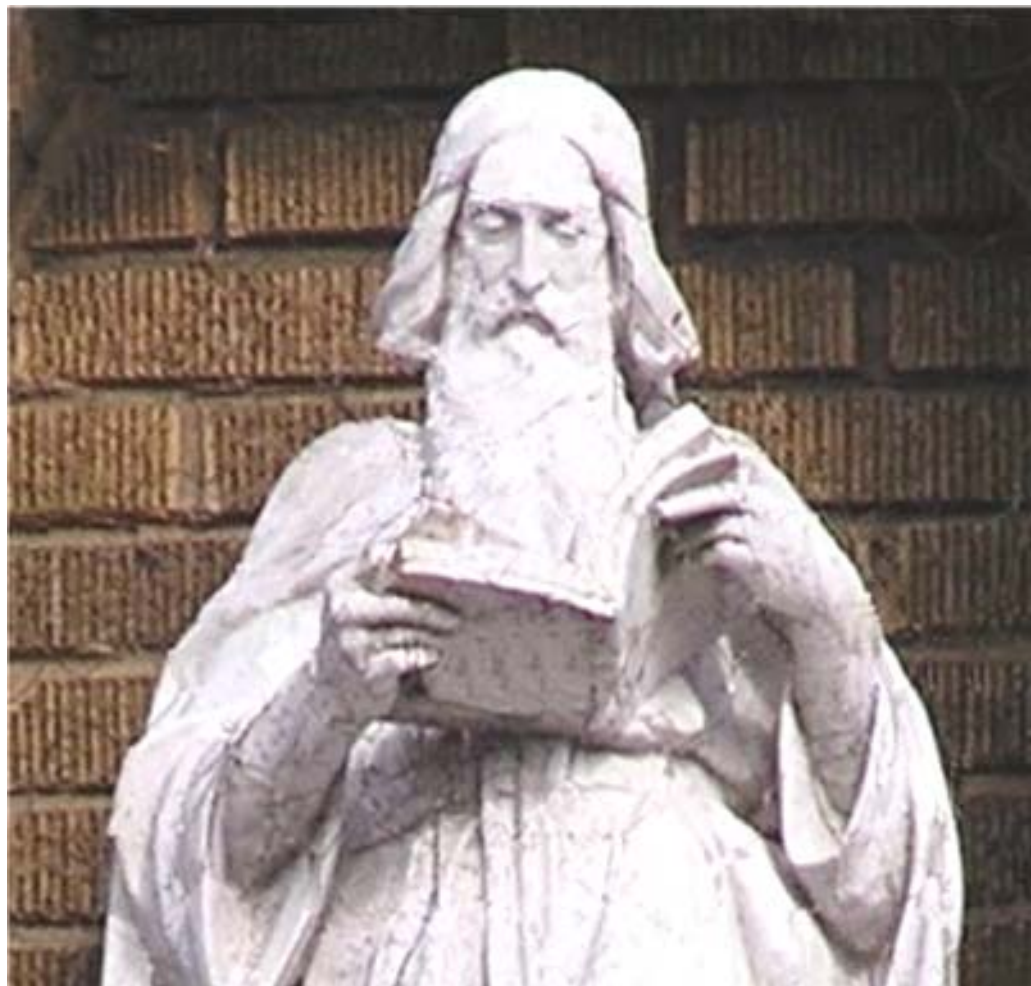

For WYD 2011 in Madrid, we are organizing a 30-day trip to some of the most important Catholic shrines (especially Marian shrines) in the entire world, and will also include many important cultural sites.
